<b>Narrative</b>								
<p>I responded to 3333 S Glenstone, the Clarion Hotel Convention Center on a report of two subjects causing a disturbance, and refusing to leave the hotel after being asked to do so by management. While enroute to the location, I was advised by dispatch that a political event was being held at the hotel. Also, another SPD officer who was working at the scene of the event notified responding officers, via radio, that the subjects appeared to be intoxicated and causing a disturbance inside where the event was being held.</p> <p>At the location, security officers on-scene pointed out the subjects, who were outside the building near the entrance of the Convention Center. I contacted the two subjects, and since I was the only officer contacting them at that point, I placed both subjects in handcuffs (double-locked/checked for proper fit). I explained to both subjects, later identified as Jeffery Kenkel and Steven Reed, that they were not under arrest at that point.</p> <p>I contacted the complainant, hotel manager Mohamed Salam, who told me Reed came into the Convention Center at approximately 1500 hours on 04-05-03, and was distributing leaflets and speaking loudly about politicians in hospitality rooms. Salam said at that time, he asked Reed to leave the premises and not return. According to Salam, Reed left the location then.</p> <p>Salam stated that at approximately 1730 hours, Reed returned to the hotel, along with Kenkel, and both were visiting hospitality rooms causing disturbances with event attendees. Salam said the two were also distributing leaflets inside and outside the Convention Center entrance. According to Salam, event organizers also advised Reed and Kenkel were causing a disturbance, and at that point, Salam and hotel security personnel asked the two to leave (1750 hours). Salam reported the two refused to leave, and still stood outside the entrance to the Convention Center distributing fliers, and Salam then called 911.</p> <p>A check of Kenkel and Reed revealed neither was wanted. I issued Reed summons #02204785 for trspassing, signed by Salam, with a municipal court date of 04-22-03 at 9:00 a.m. I issued Kenkel summons #022047484 for tresspassing, signed by Salam, with a municipal court date of 04-22-03 at 9:00 a.m. Both Kenkel and Reed were then escorted off the property and released.</p>
